

All MOUSE Squad members are required to create accounts on [mousesquad.org](http://mousesquad.org) for themselves. Many features on the site are members-only including your Squad homepage, the Knowledge Base, Certification, Forums, CaseTracker and BlogIt.

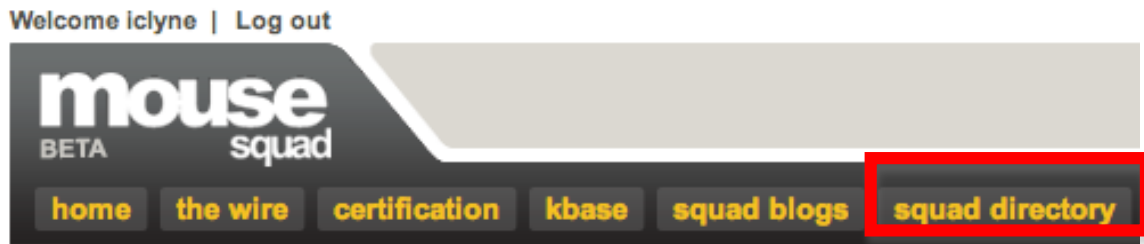
1. To create an account, go to [mousesquad.org](http://mousesquad.org), select "Create an Account" from the top above the navigation menu.
2. Choose your account type: "Student Registration".
3. On the next page, Fill out the account form with accurate information. You only need to complete those fields with the red asterisk (\*).

**NOTE:** Make sure to choose a username and password that you will remember, and use a working email address. Many features on the site require email to work.

4. Read the Terms & Conditions, select "I have read and agree to the terms" from the drop down menu below them, and click "Create New Account".



Now you will want to join your site's MOUSE Squad.



To **“Request Membership/Join”**

1. Click on **“squad directory”** on the banner menu.
2. Ask your site instructor for the name of your squad.
3. Locate **your squad** in the MOUSE Squad Directory by using the Search box. You can type in just a few letters in the squad name and it will come up.
4. Click on the **“Request Membership”** link. On the next page, click on **“Join.”**

Once your membership is approved, you will see the squad listed in your **“My Squads”** toolbox in the lower left corner. When you click on the Squad Name in **My Squads** you will see all the squad posts, blogs, certification activities and more of you squad.



Now that you have an account, you can start using the site. Click on the **“Certification”** link in the menu above to access the Training modules. The **“kBase”** (Knowledge Base) link above it provides additional training materials.
